Woman Killed, Man Injured in Shooting

*****UPDATE*****

Probable cause was established to obtain warrants for Kevawn Davenport, 22, in connection with the death of Lexus Antrom. On February 12, 2026, detectives served the warrants on Davenport while he remains hospitalized and receiving treatment for his injuries.

Davenport and Antrum were involved in a domestic dispute that led to the shooting. Davenport is charged with Murder and Possession of a Firearm During the Commission of a Crime. He will be transported to the Muscogee County Jail upon his release from the hospital.

On February 12, 2026 at 4:03 a.m., Columbus Police Officers responded to the 4500 block of Gardiner Drive in reference to a shooting. Responding officers discovered a Black female (later identified as Lexus Antrom, 28) who had been shot and was unresponsive. A male was also found with a gunshot wound. EMS transported the male to Piedmont Columbus Regional for treatment. Coroner Buddy Bryan responded to the scene and pronounced the female victim deceased at 4:50 a.m.

The Violent Crimes Unit was called to the scene to take lead on the investigation.
