CLEANING UP IS A GROUP EFFORT

Keeping our environment clean takes the cooperation of everyone in the community. While industry and government are working toward cleaning the air and water, there is a simple contribution you can make to our environment: **Adopt-A-Stop**.

EVERYONE BENEFITS

When you Adopt-A-Stop, you are showing civic pride and helping clean up our community. Bus stop adoption is simple, and when everyone joins this environmentally conscious program, the city becomes a better place to live.

ANYONE CAN JOIN

Anyone can Adopt-A-Stop: civic groups, individuals, private companies, churches, and schools. Adopters agree to pick up litter around the bus stops for one year. METRA provides adoption signs so that you receive recognition for your efforts.

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- Organizations must sign an Adopt-A-Stop agreement.
- METRA gives final approval on organizations, stops and shelters.
- Organizations must collect litter at the designated stop or shelter at least once per month.

METRA Will FURNISH:

- An Adopt-A-Stop Sign with your organization's name. Please note that for profit entities, such as businesses, are excluded.
- Please contact METRA for more information.

KEEP COLUMBUS BEAUTIFUL

Will FURNISH:

- Litter bags, gloves, safety vests (please note that safety vests will be loaned to volunteers).
- Please contact Keep Columbus Beautiful once your Agreement/Application has been filled out and submitted to METRA.

ORGANIZATION:

- Civic, non-profit or commercial organization.
- Participants must be at least 12 yrs. old (children age 12 and under are strongly discouraged from conducting any Adopt-A-Stop work, because the work will occur near a roadway).
- Provide Adopt-A-Stop status report to METRA.
- METRA advises close supervision, especially children.
- Clean-up during peak traffic hours or darkness is not recommended.
