Department of Transportation/METRA Uptown Residential Parking Agreement

The purpose of the residential permit is to provide on-street, unlimited time parking in designated Residential Parking Areas to residents who reside in the Uptown Parking Management Enforcement Area (UPMEA). Residents who do not display the valid residential parking permit will be issued a parking ticket if their vehicle violates parking ordinances.

Issuance

On-Street residential parking permits will be issued by the Department of Transportation/METRA Parking Enforcement Division, located at 919 Broadway, Columbus, Georgia 31901; Phone (706) 653-4647. For more details about the permit, contact this office

Permit Stipulations

1. Residency – Must reside within the defined Uptown Parking Management Enforcement Area.
2. Residency Verification – Must provide proof of residency within UPMEA.
 - Lease agreement or deed of residence, or
 - Current utility bill with name and address clearly shown
3. Vehicle Registration – Copy of the current vehicle registration in Muscogee County.
4. Driver's License – Resident must have a valid Driver's License.
5. Permit Restrictions
 - A. Permit is valid "only" in designated residential parking areas as assigned
 - B. The permit is not valid on other streets within the UPMEA
 - C. The permit is not valid for illegal parking, or for parking in violation of State traffic laws or City ordinances.
 - D. The permit may be revoked if a pattern of parking violations develops or parking citations are not paid.
 - E. There is a limit of two (2) parking permits per residence.
 - F. The permit is not valid in 15 minute, 30 minute.
 - G. The parking permit will include a letter or single number, which denotes residential parking area for particular vehicle (permit code), permit number.
8. Display of Permit – The residential parking permit must be displayed in the rear window of the vehicle when the vehicle is parked on the street in the designated area. If the vehicle has tinted windows or a convertible top, the prominent display of the permit in the rear of the vehicle remains the responsibility of the vehicle owner.
9. Change of Residence – If a person holding a residential parking permit moves from the address shown on the application, the permit becomes void.
10. Falsification of Information – Providing false information in support of a parking permit is cause for denial of or revocation of a residential parking permit.
11. Students – Enrolled students residing within the UPMEA may receive a permit. Students must present the residency information; tag, driver's license, registration and a valid student identification card.

12. Permit – Will indicate the permit number, residential parking code and the expiration date of the permit. The permit number will be coded to a file that tells the Enforcement Officer the parking location for the vehicle, who the permit was issued to, and where the permit owner resides. It shall be unlawful and a violation to produce or display a facsimile or counterfeit parking permit in order to evade time limitations. Fee for all residents shall be \$25 per vehicle to be paid annually upon application (maximum 2 vehicles).
13. Visitors – Must display a permit if they park on street while visiting a resident of the parking management area. One visitor hanging permit will be issued to the homeowner which will display the home address. The visitor must be parked adjacent to this address or be subject to violation.
14. Expiration of Permit – Residential parking permits are valid for one year (twelve months) and must be renewed annually by presenting license, tag, and registration and proof of residency.
15. Lost or Stolen Permits – Lost or stolen permits may be replaced for a fee of \$5.00 for the first replacement, \$10.00 for the second replacement, continuous... The replacement cost carries forward until the end of the agreement year.


