**UTILIZATION OF CARBON REDUCTION FUNDS**

**WHEREAS**, the Columbus-Phenix City Metropolitan Planning Organization (C-PCMPO) has been designated by the Governors of the States of Alabama and Georgia and who is responsible, together with the States of Alabama and Georgia, for implementing the applicable provisions of 23 USC 134 and 135 (amended by the Infrastructure Investment Jobs Act (IIJA) Sections 1201 and 1202, December, 2015); 42 USC 2000d, 7401; 49 USC 5303; 5304; 23 CFR Parts 450 and 500; 40 CFR Parts 51 and 93; and,

**WHEREAS**, these same regulations established the Carbon Reduction Program to reduce transportation emissions through eligible projects and strategies that support cleaner, more efficient, and sustainable mobility options; and

**WHEREAS**, the Columbus-Phenix City Metropolitan Planning Organization (C-PCMPO) has been allocated a total of \$835,609.00 in Carbon Reduction Program funds for the current funding cycle; and

**WHEREAS** the MPO intends to utilize these Carbon Reduction funds for the following eligible project: Phenix City requests the design and construction of a sidewalk project along 11<sup>th</sup> Street, 12<sup>th</sup> Street, and 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue to connect the Phenix City Lively District area to the existing Riverwalk.


