## WHAT DO I PUT IN MY BLUE CART?

Recycling only! Please place plastic bottles, jars, and jugs, aluminum, tin, and steel cans, paper, and flattened cardboard loose (no bagging). Glass can be brought to one of our recycling drop off centers.

## WHEN IS MY COLLECTION DAY?

Household garbage and recycling are collected on the same day. If you do not know your garbage pickup day, call 706-653-4000 or visit the resources page on our website.

## HOW DO I SET MY CART OUT PROPERLY ON COLLECTION DAY?

Please place your cart curbside before 7:00am on your collection day. Make sure the cart is at least 3 feet away from your garbage cart, yard waste cart, mailbox, and cars to ensure it is accessible for pick up.

## CAN I TAKE MY CART WITH ME IF I MOVE?

No. Carts are registered at an address and are the property of the City of Columbus Public Works. Please leave the cart if you move.
